Key Stage Two Curriculum Requirements for Geography

In Key Stage 1 at Downham C of E Primary School, pupils deepen their understanding of the world and how people interact with it. They explore local, national, and global places, learning about physical features like rivers, mountains, and volcanoes, as well as human features such as towns, transport, and industry. Pupils develop advanced map skills, use atlases and digital tools, and carry out fieldwork to collect and interpret data. Through engaging lessons and hands-on activities, they make connections between environments, understand how places change over time, and begin to think about sustainability. Key Stage 2 geography helps pupils become confident, curious learners ready to explore and understand the wider world.

- extend their knowledge and understanding beyond the local area to include
- the United Kingdom and Europe, north and south America
- this will include the location of a range of the world’s most significant human and physical features

- Develop their use of geographical knowledge, understanding and skills to enhance their locational and place knowledge
