### **Key Stage One Curriculum Requirements for History**

In Key Stage 1 at Downham C of E Primary School, pupils begin their journey as young geographers by exploring the world around them. They learn about their local area, noticing the features of their school, village, or town, and start to make comparisons with places further afield. Pupils explore simple maps, atlases, and globes, develop an understanding of basic physical features like rivers, hills, and forests, and begin to appreciate how people live and work in different environments. Through hands-on activities, fieldwork, and observations, pupils build curiosity and confidence, laying the foundation for a lifelong love of geography.

As historians, pupils should be taught to:

#### **Pupils should develop an awareness of:**

- the past
- using common words and
- phrases relating to the passing of time.

#### **Pupils should:**

- changes within living memory;
- events beyond living memory;
- the lives of significant individuals; significant historical events, people and places in their own locality.
